### National Trust Heritage Week Festival: Tempe House Open Days

Historic Tempe House and St Magdalene's Chapel on the shore of the Cooks River are being opened to the public as part of the National Trust's Heritage Week Festival celebrations.

Tempe House, on the original Tempe estate, was one of the earliest buildings constructed in the Rockdale area. It was the 1836 residence of A.B. Spark, and was designed by the noted colonial architect John Verge. The house and Chapel are in excellent condition, having being recently restored and are situated in a beautiful landscaped setting in relatively original condition.

The open days will be an opportunity to experience this importance piece of Rockdale's heritage and learn more about the history of the local area. Everyone is welcome to attend this event.
